ABOUT THE FESTIVAL

The City of London Festival was founded in 1962 with the objective of revitalising cultural life throughout the Square Mile. It attracts leading musicians and other artists from all over the world for three weeks each June and July. The Festival features over 100 concerts, exhibitions and other events annually and draws the public to many of the City's great buildings and open spaces – the livery halls, churches and landmark buildings (old and new), not least Christopher Wren's masterpiece, St Paul's Cathedral, which is host to several performances. As well as organising the City of London Festival, The City Arts Trust also provides a substantial and growing education programme with schools and community groups in the City and adjoining boroughs throughout the year.
